MotionX-GPS

Introduction

This year's event we are going to trial live tracking. This is achieved with the use of the MotionX-GPS app. This app is only available for iOS (iPad/iPhone) users and requires an upfront purchase plus data usage on the day.

Download

You will need to head to the app store on your iOS device and search for MotionX-GPS (or MotionX-GPS HD on iPad) and purchase the app.



Play

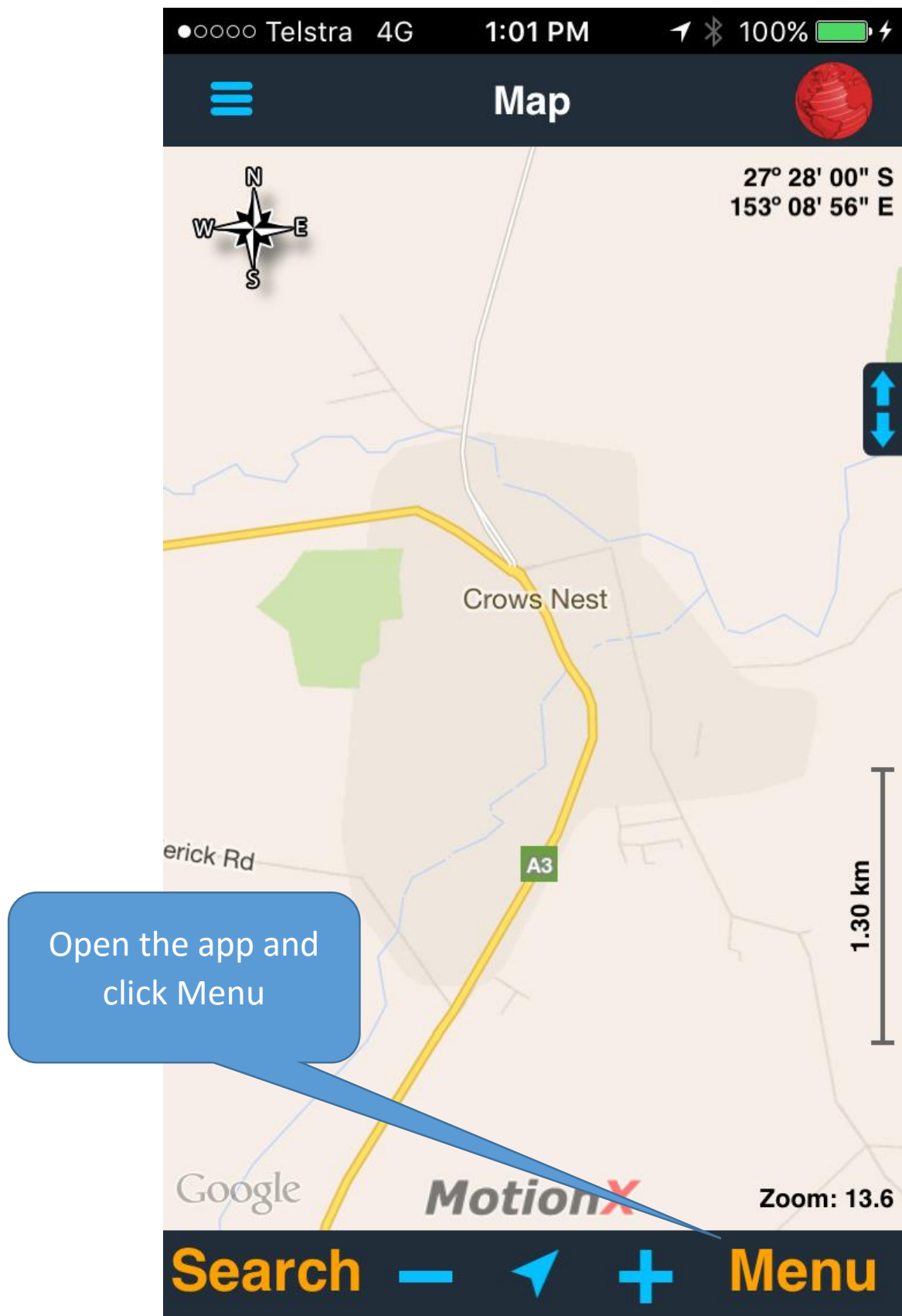
I would recommend before the event that you have a play with the app to familiarise yourself with it.

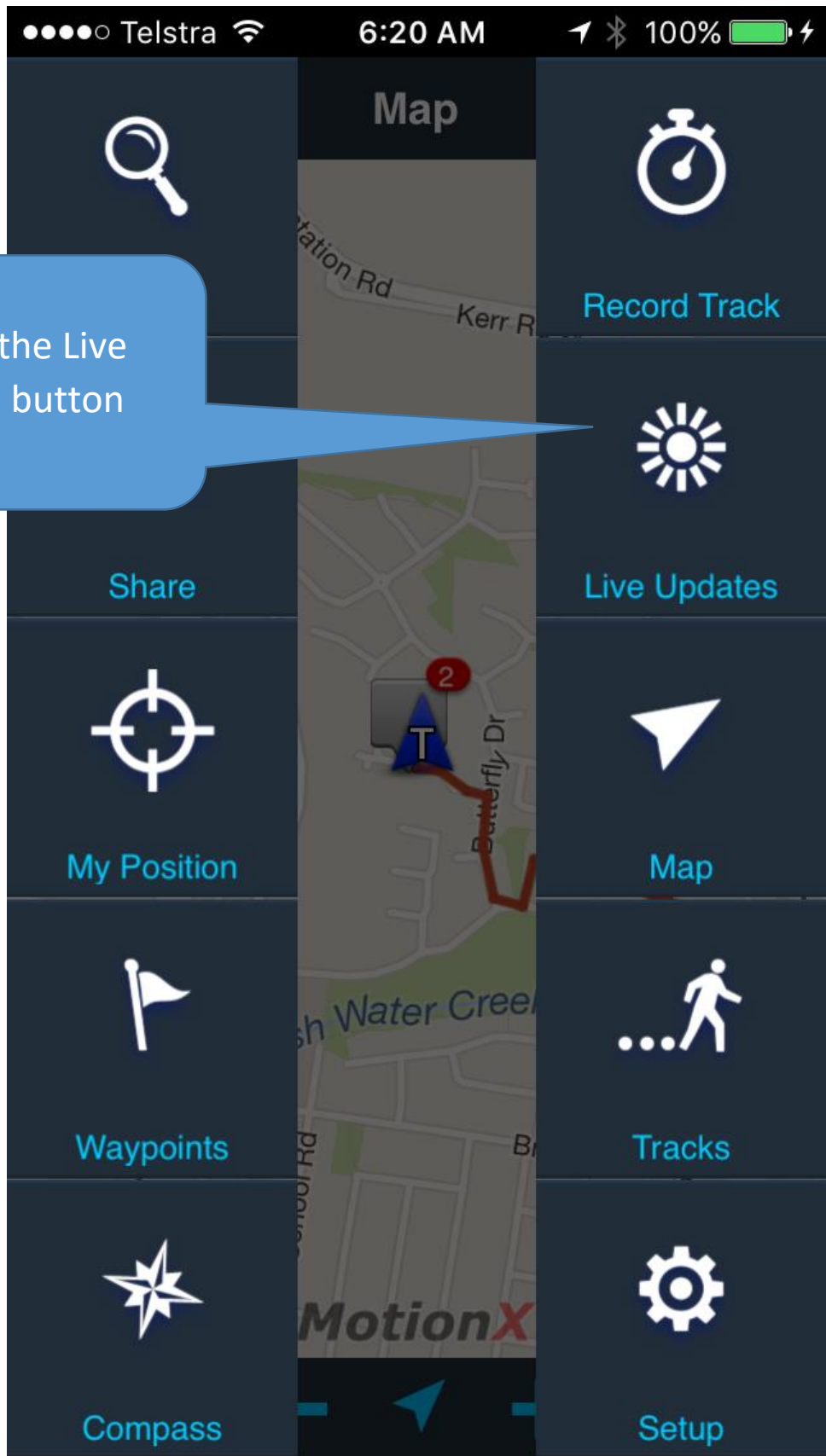
This is a very well featured piece of software for the price, you could run the whole event from here alone if you chose to do so, but only if you are familiar with it.
